BOTANICAL CHECKLIST

- WILDFLOWERS
- \_\_\_ COREOPSIS, a.k.a. "Tickseed" (*Cortaderia selloana*)  
Sunny yellow petals, grows in mass

\_\_\_ PURPLE CONEFLOWER (*Echinacea purpurea*)  
Daisy-like with a large cone, lavender-purple petals

\_\_\_ JOE PYE WEED (*Eupatorium fistulosum*)  
Tall with clusters of pink-purple flowers

\_\_\_ BLANKET FLOWER (*Gallardia pulchella*)  
Carpet of flowers with garnet-red & yellow-gold petals

\_\_\_ BLACK-EYED SUSAN (*Rudbeckia hirta*)  
Brown-black center with golden-yellow petals

- NATIVE PLANTS, SHRUBS
- \_\_\_ SAW PALMETTO (*Serenoa repens*)  
Spiky palms near the marsh, up to 6-feet high

\_\_\_ CAROLINA JESSAMINE (*Gelsemium sempervirens*)  
High-climbing, yellow-flowering vine

\_\_\_ SWEETGRASS (*Muhlenbergii capilaris*)  
Basketmaking grass with pink-purple, fuzzy blooms

\_\_\_ AMERICAN BEAUTYBERRY (*Callicarpa americana*)  
Often grows under pines, purple berries in fall

\_\_\_ WAX MYRTLE (*Myrica cerifera*)  
Glossy green leaves and gray berries, a.k.a. "Southern bayberry"



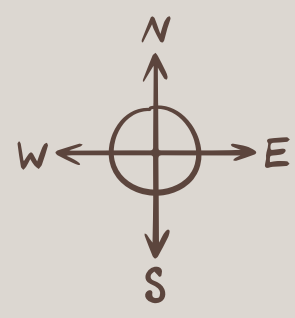
Happy trails to you! Enjoy each trail for its own unique adventures: *The Farm Trail* features farm fields, a wildflower meadow, and spoonbills fishing in Appapoola creek. *Eventide Trail* offers sights and sounds of the farm, and Great Oak Basin water views. *Sea Island Trail* showcases birdlife on the ponds and dolphin breaching, while *Maritime Trail* meanders by more birdlife, long marsh views and shady grand oaks.

**TRAILS**

- FARM TRAIL = 1 mile
- EVENTIDE TRAIL = ¾ mile
- OAK PARK TRAIL = ½ mile
- BELL COVE TRAIL = ½ mile
- JACK ISLAND TRAIL = 1 mile
- SEA ISLAND TRAIL = 3 miles
- MARITIME TRAIL = 3½ miles

**LOOPS**

- WIDGEON LOOP = 3 miles
- SHIPPON LOOP = 2¼ miles
- SALT TRAIL LOOP = 3½ miles
